





WILLIAM HENRY THOMAS



William Henry Thomas (November 4, 1858-June 4, 1929) was a skilled craftsman. He was born and raised in what was then the village of Martinsville in the 1860s-1880s. He attended Hampton Institute (now Hampton University) in the 1890s, where "he studied carpentry, embraced the tradition of service." and returned home to build the three-room structure which became the Dry Bridge Colored School," a school that would serve the community for almost thirty years. According to U. S. Census Records, Mr. Thomas served as a Henry County teacher in 1900. He was also a Founding Elder of Grace Presbyterian Church. Known for his meticulous craft as a carpenter, "his work remains evident as Martinsville residents drive along Starling Avenue, Fayette Street, and Brookdale Street (formerly Old Danville Road)." Today, there is a memorial tree on Church Street at the corner of Ellsworth Street across from his birthplace in honor of William Henry Thomas.

For it matters not, how much we own, the cars...the house...the cash. What matters is how we live and love and how we spend our dash.


So, think about this long and hard. Are there things you'd like to change? For you never know how much time is left that can still be rearranged.



In the year of 1948, Tau Omicron Chapter was issued a Charter by the National Headquarters of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity for the communities of Martinsville and Danville. The chapter began with nine (9) charter members who was prominent, professional figures in the education (school administrators), medical and business fields. The Brotherhood established a regular monthly meeting schedule that rotated between Martinsville and Danville.

Charter members: Gene Banks, Robert Hairston Sr., James Hughes, Charles Richardson, James Slade, J. Elmer Turner, William 'Bill' Turner, Clyde Williams, R.O. Wilson.

Tau Omicron continued to grow as new Brothers moved into the two communities served by the chapter. With the continued growth, it was decided that it would be beneficial for the two communities to establish separate chapters in each community. At the time of separation, it was agreed that the charter would remain in Martinsville and the brothers in Danville would seek a new Charter, thus becoming Rho lota in 1968.

Clyde Williams became the newly elected Basileus of Tau Omicron with a membership of ten Brothers. In 1977, Tau Omicron of Martinsville, initiated it's first member into the fraternity, Brother William Howell. Tau Omicron, now consisting of brothers from only the Martinsville - Henry County community region, began to get more involved in the black community by sponsoring more of the Fraternities' mandated programs.

As years passed more brothers moved into the area, joined Tau Omicron and became community servant agents.

Since 2005, the cornerstone of Tau Omicron's service to the Martinsville – Henry County community has been the QUE School mentoring program. This initiative, rooted in mentorship and guidance, has shaped countless lives over the years. Through mentorship, education, and empowerment, the program has become a beacon of hope, nurturing future leaders and fostering positive change within the community. The impact of the QUE School resonates deeply, weaving a tapestry of resilience and empowerment throughout

Martinsville - Henry County.
